



Why Halifax Nova Scotia?




- Given the COVID restriction it was sensible to select one of the venues we had to cancel in 2020/2021

Where is Halifax Nova Scotia?







Halifax, an Atlantic Ocean port in eastern Canada, is the provincial capital of Nova Scotia. A major business center, it's also known for its maritime history. The city is dominated by the hilltop Citadel, a star-shaped fort completed in the 1850s.

Waterfront warehouses known as the Historic Properties recall Halifax's days as a trading hub for privateers, notably during the War of 1812.

In November Halifax has an average day time temperature of 6°C/43°F



The 2022 Symposium



The Symposium will take place at the Halifax Convention Centre

- Over 120,000 square feet of flexible event space, including:
 - 30,000 square foot ballroom overlooking the city

Symposium Venue – Halifax Convention Centre


















Symposium Venue – Halifax Convention Centre




Argyle Level




Demonstration Themes

- Halifax Search and Rescue (SAR) "Dumping Day"








Timber Sweet










IDLS2022 Floorplan


